

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-2

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC SAFETY LIT FUND

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 6-3.6-6 authorizes the municipal entities to establish a Local Income Tax Public Safety fund for public safety to receive transfers of funds raised by a general or special tax levy for purposes of local public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Howard County has established such a fund and proceeds from said fund are being shared with the Town of Greentown for purposes of public safety; and

WHEREAS the Town Council of the Town of Greentown now determines it is in the best interest of the town and its taxpayers that a public safety Local Income Tax (LIT) fund be established for the purposes of accepting and accumulating funds for the public safety operations of the municipality and to pay such public safety expenditures as defined by Indiana Code § 6-3.6-2-14;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL of the TOWN OF GREENTOWN, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I.

Creation of the Public Safety LIT Fund. There is hereby established and created a “Public Safety LIT Fund” to receive transfers of public safety LIT funds raised by a general or special tax levy on taxable property within the Town of Greentown or from other municipal entities authorized by law to share said funds with the Town of Greentown. The fund shall be known as the “Public Safety LIT Fund” and shall be fund number 2204.

SECTION II.

Purposes of the Public Safety LIT Fund. The funds on deposit in the Public Safety LIT Fund may be used for any permissible operations of the Town of Greentown, which are related to public safety as defined by Indiana Code § 6-3.6-2-14;

SECTION III.

Transfers to Public Safety LIT Fund. The Town Council of the Town of Greentown may, from time to time, accept Public Safety LIT Funds made available to it and said funds may be transferred to the Public Safety LIT Fund for use in public safety operations including, but limited to, Public Safety LIT funds from Howard County and / or from the State of Indiana as allowed by Indiana Code § 6-3.6-6.

SECTION IV.

Appropriations. The Town Council of the Town of Greentown may authorize expenditures of funds from the Public Safety LIT Fund by appropriations made in the same manner as other funds are appropriated that receive tax moneys upon making a finding that the proposed use of the funds is consistent with the intent of the fund.

SECTION V.



SECTION VI.


Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of the date of passage by the Town Council of the Town of Greentown and publication, if any, as provided by law.




